
Downloading your Web Design Diploma work from GitHub

1. In your web browser, go to your account on GitHub. The web address will be similar to the following:


https://github.com/marysmith

- 2. If you are not already signed in to your GitHub account, sign in now.
- 3. Click on the repository that holds all your Web Design work. Its name will be similar to:


marysmith.github.io



4. On the next screen, click the green button named Code.



From the drop-down list of options, click **Download ZIP**.



All your folders and files will now be compressed into a single ZIP file and transferred down to the **Downloads** folder on your computer. Your downloaded file will have a name such as **marysmith.github.io-master.zip**.

That is step one completed.
